

BICYCLE PERMISSION SLIP
RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. An approved bicycle helmet must be worn and worn properly when operating bicycle. This is a New Jersey law for all children under age 17. See the Parent-Student Handbook for more details.
2. Obey all traffic rules of the road.
3. Bicycle must be walked across intersection at school following directions of crossing guard.
4. Bicycle must be walked at all times on school property.
5. Bicycle must be placed in bicycle rack and locked. School will not be responsible for stolen bicycles.
6. Students may not carry passengers on bicycle.
7. Students must be in grade 3 or higher to ride bicycles to school unattended by a parent or guardian.
