March 2019 Health Office Report

This month our school dentist, Dr. Abraham, provided dental screening for students in grades 1, 3, 5, & 7. I sent notices to parents after the screening as to whether additional dental services were advised. Dr. Abraham is Dr. Forte's associate and we are fortunate to have their practice continue to provide screenings services at no charge. I continued working on health screenings and made referrals to parents for follow up as needed.

I completed teaching Adult CPR & AED training to one section of 8th grade students and then started teaching the same class to the other 8th grade section. I also continued teaching Family Life to 5th grade students. I taught a scoliosis informational class to 4th grade as this is the students first year to have this school screening. I coordinated the scoliosis screening schedule with the teachers and will begin screenings in April. Parents who requested scoliosis screening for their child were sent a reminder notice about the screening.

One of our local orthodontists presented a class to our 4th grade students about dental health and orthodontic care. This was a complimentary presentation and was enjoyed by the students and teachers. I coordinated and held our required School Wellness meeting this month. Invitations were sent to parents about the meeting and it was posted on the school website. The meeting was attended by parents, students, administration, PE staff, lunchroom staff and myself.

I attended the quarterly meeting of the Camden County School Nurse's Association which was about vaping. I also participated in a webinar on Nutrition Fads & Fiction. On our staff inservice day I attended relevant meetings and also worked on preparing our Right to Know Survey which needs to be done every 5 years.
